

In 2014, they advanced to the finals of the NCAA DII National Tournament.

Josh Templeton is the head boys basketball coach at St Benedicts Academy in Memphis, TN. A two-time NCCAA All-American, his point guard clinic is a highlight for all. He connects with young people and can teach the game in a way that helps each camper improve. He also directs several PGC camps in the summer, and his specialties are player development and helping to develop the offense.
